

## City of Laguna Niguel Police Services

In the City of Laguna Niguel, Police services are provided by contract with the Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD). The Sheriff's Department is responsible for providing the protection of citizens, the enforcement of laws, and crime prevention. Law enforcement services include patrol, traffic enforcement, accident analysis and investigation, parking enforcement, general and special investigations, and the Community Support Unit.

The City of Laguna Niguel enjoys the reputation of being one of the safest cities in Orange County, and has one of the lowest crime rates in the county since 1992. We attribute this to a combination of factors including the level of contract law enforcement services, demographic makeup of the community, land use patterns, household income and education, private and gated communities, and our dedicated community members.

The City is dedicated in its crime fighting strategy as well as maintaining an atmosphere of community. There are several programs available to residents and businesses in the city. The Police Services Department encourages community members to participate in our endeavor to preserve the quality of life in Laguna Niguel.

Neighborhood Watch is a crime prevention program that enlists the active participation of citizens in cooperation with law enforcement to reduce crime in their communities. Neighbors get to know each other and work together in a program of mutual assistance while being trained to recognize and report suspicious activity in their neighborhood.

## Business Watch

## Home Security Checks

With this FREE service, a Crime Prevention Specialist comes to your home to inspect the security of your home and offer suggestions where needed.

## PACT

This “Police Auxiliary Citizen’s Team” (PACT) is a group of senior volunteers who assist with various duties within police services.

## Ready Laguna Niguel

Ready Laguna Niguel is a trio of integrated programs intended to focus on the challenges from and responses to emergencies and disasters; both personally and community wide. Educational presentations, community outreach, and volunteer opportunities comprise this concerted effort to prepare the citizens for emergencies; both common and rare.

## Vacation Home Checks

This FREE service involves a physical check of your home to ensure it remains secure while you are away on vacation.

## YANA

The “You Are Not Alone” (YANA) program is designed for Laguna Niguel residents. YANA provides a measure of security and well-being for those who are primarily alone. This FREE program offers the residents of Laguna Niguel a sense of security by checking on the welfare of those who have requested it.



## Proof of Corrections

If you receive a citation for a violation that requires evidence of correction, the Police Services Dept. is available during business hours to provide a “Proof of Correction” citation sign-off.

## Child Car Seat Inspections

A Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician is available by appointment to inspect your child’s car seat or booster seat installation.

## School Safety & Officer Friendly

Our Community Support Officer is available by appointment to give various presentations to students. Such presentations include internet safety and drug education.

Deputies are also available by appointment to give Officer Friendly presentations. This FREE service is designed to humanize children’s perceptions of law enforcement and their work. Children will also walk away from the presentation with an increased knowledge of police vehicles and equipment.
