Council Member Elaine Gennawey Elected as Chair of the Association of California Cities-Orange County (ACC-OC) Legislative and Regulatory Committee and as an ACC-OC Director

Laguna Niguel, CA – On Friday, November 20, 2020, City Council Member Elaine Gennawey was unanimously elected as Chair of the Legislative and Regulatory Committee by the Association of California Cities – Orange County (ACC-OC) Board of Directors and was appointed as an ACC-OC Director.



The ACC-OC represents the interests of Orange County cities on regional public policy issues. The ACC-OC membership base consists of the cities of Orange County, dozens of local government special districts, businesses, non-profits and higher education institutions. The organization was established in 2011 under the philosophy that Orange County cities need to have a collaborative voice on public policy issues impacting the community.

As Chair of the Legislative and Regulatory Committee, Council Member Gennawey will lead the committee in reviewing, analyzing, and making recommendations on regional, state, and federal legislation and regulatory matters. Council Member Gennawey has served on the Legislative and Regulatory Committee since 2015.

“My continued work on this committee reflects our City Council’s commitment to Laguna Niguel residents to advocate for legislation that best serves our residents, and oppose legislation that erodes local control,” said Council Member Gennawey.

Voting members of the committee are appointed by the ACC-OC Board of Directors and serve a two-year term that runs concurrent with the California State Legislative calendar. Council Member Gennawey’s newly elected role will begin January 2021 and will go through December 2022.
