Implemented a bicycle patrol team to monitor commercial areas.



300 tons of asphalt was used to repairing City streets.




TREES TRIMMED

OPEN SPACE & ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVATION


TRAIL GUIDE

Expanded the Goat Grazing weed abatement program and hosted a meet and greet event with over 600 people in attendance.




